Veterans Day is an official <u>United States public holiday</u>, observed annually on November 11, that honors <u>military</u> <u>veterans</u>; that is, persons who served in the <u>United States Armed Forces</u>. It coincides with other holidays, including <u>Armistice Day</u> and <u>Remembrance Day</u>, celebrated in other countries that mark the anniversary of the end of <u>World War I</u>; major hostilities of World War I were formally ended at the 11th hour of the 11th day of the 11th month of 1918, when the <u>Armistice with Germany</u> went into effect. The United States previously observed Armistice Day. The U.S. holiday was renamed Veterans Day in 1954.
